

The Board of Intermediate Education is extending the following concessions to the Blind, Deaf, Deaf & Dumb And Physically Disabled Candidates at Intermediate level.

Nature of disability	Concessions & Exemptions
A) Blind, Deaf, Deaf & Dumb And Physically Disabled students of I & II year	Relaxation of jumbling system in public examinations I & II year.
B) Blind, Deaf, Deaf & Dumb students of I & II year	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> a) To provide trained teachers only to attend the valuation of answer papers. b) Reduction of pass marks from 35% to 25% for all subjects (Awarding division will be as per usual procedure).
C) Deaf, Deaf & Dumb	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> a) Exemption from the payment of examination fee. b) Extending 30 minutes extra time at Intermediate Public examination (I & II year) c) The students who wish to study vocational courses, are exempted from studying communication skills in English language. d) Exemption of one language under part-I or Part-II
D) Blind	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> a) Exemption from the payment of examination fee. b) Extending 30 minutes extra time at Intermediate Public examination (I & II year) c) Providing Scribe (The Chief Superintendent should satisfy himself of total blindness of the candidate - but no medical certificate is to be insisted upon).
E) Physically handicapped	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> a) Exemption from the payment of examination fee. b) Extending 30 minutes extra time at Intermediate Public examination (I & II year) c) Providing Scribe to those who are incapable of using hands due to accident illness and should duly supported by medical certificate.

The above exemptions and concessions will come into force with effect from Intermediate Public Examinations, March 2002 and onwards.
