This is to notify that, the following are the prescribed due dates for payment of examination fee by **Second year** Regular students, ex-failed candidates (General and Vocational) and Attendance exempted private candidates (without college study) for Humanities groups and candidates with change of Group who wish to appear for the ensuing Intermediate Public Examinations, March 2012:

The above due dates are applicable to both **General and Vocational students**, Attendance exempted private candidates for Humanities only (without college study) and candidates who wish to appear for the ensuing Intermediate Public Examinations, March 2012 with change of group.

IMPROVEMENT OF PERFORMANCE:

Chance of improvement should be availed within two years of passing the Intermediate Public Examinations only. Two chances are allowed for improvement, subject to the condition that such candidates should not prosecute their higher studies during this period. An undertaking to this effect has to be given by the candidate.

Eligibility to award Pass Certificate:

All the candidates who are admitted to appear Intermediate Public Examinations, shall have to complete the course within a period of 5 (five) years from the year of first appearance.

The candidates admitted into Intermediate Course during 2007-2008 are eligible to appear for Intermediate Public Examinations, March 2012 and Intermediate Public Advanced Supplementary Examinations, May/June 2012 as a last chance and they cannot claim their old performance to clear backlog papers.

All the failed candidates who could not clear their backlog papers within 5 (five) years will forgo their previous performance and have to appear for all the subjects as fresh candidates.

ATTENDANCE EXEMPTION

The Principals of the Govt. Junior Colleges have to accept the Examination application forms along with examination fee Demand Drafts in respect of Private Candidates (without college study) after thorough scrutiny and after satisfying about their eligibility to appear for Intermediate Public Examinations, March 2012. The Examination fee once paid will not be refunded or adjusted in case the candidate is found to be not eligible to appear Intermediate Public Examinations, March 2012.

Candidates who have a gap of two years after passing the qualifying examination i.e., S.S.C. or its equivalent examination are eligible to appear for both 1st and 2nd year.

All the Private candidates who submitted their applications for exemption from attendance (without college study) and who intend to appear for 1st or 2nd year Intermediate Public Examinations, March 2012 for the first time will have to answer the papers with syllabus prescribed for the regular students of March 2012.

The candidates who have passed their S.S.C. or its equivalent examination from Board University other than Andhra Pradesh have to obtain Eligibility Certificate from the Board of Intermediate Education, A.P., Hyderabad to appear for Intermediate Public Examinations, March 2012.

The Examination application forms can be had from the Office of the Regional Inspection Officer, Board of Intermediate Education, in the District concerned on payment of Rs.10/- (Rupees Ten only).

It is informed that there will be no further extension of examination fee due dates. The candidates who fail to pay the examination fee in time or with late fee should invariably apply for Tatkal scheme only which will be announced in the month of November/December 2011. As such all the Principals and Managements are requested to give wide publicity to the above fee due dates among the students, parents and the staff of their respective Colleges.
