With reference to the above subject cited, the Government of India, Ministry of Science and Technology, Department of Science & Technology (DST), New Delhi, has been implementing a Special Programme for attraction of talents for study of Science and careers in research. The Programme is called "Innovation in Science Pursuit for Inspired Research" (INSPIRE). Under the 'INSPIRE' Scheme a component Programme is "Scholarship for Higher Education" (SHE). The Government of India has approved this Programme. Total 7,500 Scholarships are available annually under SHE in India. The Scholarships are limited only to the candidates studying courses in Natural / Basic Sciences at B.Sc., B.Sc. (Hons.), Integrated M.Sc./MS Programmes with Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry and Life Sciences in any one of the recognized institutions in India. The Scheme in its current format does not include courses in Engineering, Medicine, Technology and other professional courses. The current scheme has approved 7,500 scholarships in India and each valued at **Rs.80,000/-** are announced annually based on top 1% performance in IPE, March, 2011 of the total number of students appeared. The approved distribution formula for each Board is pro-rata on the total number of candidates appeared for each Board visa-a-vis to the number of students appeared in the class-XII examinations in the entire country.

The top 1% of IPE, March, 2011 candidates list of your college is sent herewith along with “**Advisory note to the candidate for Eligibility in Scholarship for Higher Education (SHE), component under INSPIRE Scheme**” as per the marks secured in IPE March, 2011. The Principal is requested to hand over the Advisory Note to the concerned student within (03) days from the date of receipt and ask him to follow the instructions from Advisory Note. The details of the Scheme and other instructions are provided in Advisory Note circulated to the students through the Junior College concerned and any further information and details sought under this Scheme are available at the website: www.inspire-dst.gov.in or may be approached to **the Department of Science & Technology (DST), Technology Bhavan, New Mehrauli Road, New Delhi 110016 only.**
