Sub:- BIE, A.P. – Central Sector Scheme of Scholarships for college and University students for the year 2010-11 – Forwarding of application forms to provisionally selected candidates of IPE March 2010 – Reg.

The Ministry of HRD, Government of India, New Delhi has introduced a new “Central Sector Scheme of Scholarships for College and University Students” from the financial year 2008-09.

The eligibility to apply for the scholarship is (a) The student should get minimum of above 80<sup>th</sup> percentile of successful candidates in the relevant stream at +2 stage i.e., in IPE March, 2010. (b) Parental income shall not exceed Rs.4.5 lakhs PA (i.e. who do not belong to creamy layer), (c) Who pursue regular/professional degree course in recognized educational institutions, (d) Who do not avail any other scholarship are eligible.

The scholarships are divided among boys and girls in the ratio of 1:1 & among Science, Commerce and Humanities in the ratio of 3:2:1.

The reservation applicable for award of scholarships is as follows: SC 15%, ST 7.5%, OBC 27% and PH 3%. Applicants of these categories have to attach attested copies of caste / PH certificates issued by the competent authority.

The Scholarship will be paid from the month of admission in the college @ the following rates. (i) @ Rs.1000/- P.M. for a maximum period of 10 months in an academic year for degree/ professional degree course and can be renewed for 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> year, depending on promotion to next class, provided he/she secures 60% or more marks, with an attendance of at least 75%, with good behaviour. He/She shall apply for **renewal for every year**, on or before **15<sup>th</sup> July of every year**. The **renewal application** may be down loaded from BIE Website **www.bieap.gov.in**. (ii) @ Rs.2000/- P.M for 4<sup>th</sup> & 5<sup>th</sup> year for a maximum period of 10 months for professional degree /P.G. course. For all professional courses, scholarship will be renewed till the graduation level of that course subject to maximum of five years. (iii) The amount will be transferred to the bank account of the student. The student has to furnish the correct Bank account particulars as mentioned at Sl.No.12 of application form and in Data Sheet at Sl.No.11. (iv) The **Principal of degree / professional degree college** has to fill the particulars of joining report and submit along with this application form.

The provisionally selected list of candidates of your college is sent herewith along with the proceedings and applications as per the marks secured in IPE March 2010. These selections are related to the current financial year 2010-11. All the details of the scheme and other instructions are provided in the proceedings circulated to the provisionally selected candidates through the Junior College concerned. The Principal is requested to go through the proceedings and keep one copy of the same as office copy and follow the instructions scrupulously. This information is also placed in BIE website [www.bieap.gov.in](http://www.bieap.gov.in).

The last cut of marks of provisionally selected candidates for the current year 2010-11 (based on the marks of IPE, March 2010) of various categories are as follows:
