**APPLICATIONS INVITED FOR ESTABLISHMENT OF NEW PRIVATE UN-AIDED  
JUNIOR COLLEGES IN THE STATE FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2008-2009**

In pursuance of the order of the Government in G.O.Rt.No.419 Higher Education (IE.II) Dept., dated 6-5-2008, applications are hereby invited from the interested Registered Educational Societies / Trusts for establishment of new Private Un-aided Junior Colleges in the State for the academic year 2008-09 in accordance with the guidelines issued vide G.O.Ms.No.29 Education Dept., dated 5-2-1987, G.O.Ms.No.114 Higher Education (CE.III.2) Dept., dated 9-8-2000, G.O.Ms.No.12 HE (IE.II) Dept., dated 9-3-2002, G.O.Ms.No.79 HE (IE.II) Dept., dated 21-7-2005 & G.O.Ms.No.05 HE (CE.I) Dept., dated 8-1-2008.

The managements are requested to download the latest prescribed application Form-I which is made available from today i.e., 16-05-2008 in the BIE website ("[www.bieap.gov.in](http://www.bieap.gov.in)"). They should enclose a D.D. of Rs.500/- separately towards the cost of application form in addition to inspection fee drawn in favour of the Secretary, Board of Intermediate Education, A.P. payable at Hyderabad. The details of identified Mandals and Municipalities are available at BIE website. The interested Educational Societies / Trusts may submit their applications along with all enclosures at the office of the Secretary, B.I.E. A.P. Hyderabad on or before **06-06-2008**. The incomplete applications i.e., applications without prescribed fee, enclosures, etc., and applications received after the due date will be rejected. Any fee once paid to the BIE shall not be refunded. The B.I.E. will not be responsible for any postal delay.

Further all the Managements who wish to apply for establishment of new private un-aided Jr. Colleges are required to provide playground facility (2 acres in Rural area and 1 acre in Urban area in a single premises). They are also required to apply for and obtain Fire Safety Certificate from Fire Safety Department. Colleges in Urban area should provide parking area to an extent of 20% of the total built up area. (i.e., 1600 sft for 8000 sft). Such parking area has to be provided either in the college premises or within a distance of 100 mtrs thereof.
