**APPLICATIONS ARE INVITED FOR ESTABLISHMENT OF NEW PRIVATE  
UN-AIDED JUNIOR COLLEGES IN THE STATE FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR  
2012-2013**

Applications are hereby invited from Public / Private Managements for the establishment new private un-aided Junior colleges in the State of Andhra Pradesh for the academic year 2012-13.

The managements / Educational societies / Trusts / Agencies registered under relevant public societies act are requested to apply in accordance with the guidelines issued vide G.O.Ms.No.29, Education Dept., dated 5-2-1987, G.O.Ms.No.114 Higher Education (CE.III.2) Dept., dated 9-8-2000, G.O.Ms.No.12 HE (IE.II) Dept., dated 9-3-2002, G.O.Ms.No.79 HE (IE.II) Dept., dated 21-7-2005 & G.O.Ms.No.05 HE (CE.I) Dept., dated 08-01-2008 webbed with detailed instructions / Guidelines / emanated, issued by the Secretary, BIE from time to time.

Details of identified areas where new colleges are to be opened (viz. rural mandals, / municipalities / municipal corporations / GHMC etc. are posted and made available in the web site of BIE ("[www.bieap.gov.in](http://www.bieap.gov.in)")

The managements are requested to go through all the four stages of processing the applications by scrupulously adhering to the instruction and guidelines that can be had / downloaded from the website.

Stage - I: The Managements / Educational society / Trusts can download the general instructions / sample application form / challan format from the website of the BIE. Prescribed fee for application and inspection have to be paid together as detailed in the website.

Stage - II: After paying the prescribed fees, the Managements / Society / Trusts upload their transaction id provided by Bank authorities. After a gap of 3 working days of paying fees by way of challan and entering data online they can obtain a user-id and password through e-mail if transaction id is correct.

Stage - III: Obtaining the password enables the management / society / Trust to upload the prescribed application form along with required documents as per the guidelines made available on the official website of the BIE.

The submission of application online i.e. Stage- II onwards will commence on 01.02.2012. The last date for submission of applications online is 28.02.2012. The website will freeze all online applications at 5 P.M. on 28-02-2012. No application after prescribed date will either be accepted

by the BIE or by the RIO's concerned. Applications uploaded online within the prescribed date alone will be taken up for further processing.

Any application without sufficient fee, required built up area, registered lease deed of building and play ground, approved building plan, Parking area, 2 photographs of the buildings and 1 photo of Correspondent, Structural soundness certificate, a copy of application and challan submitted to Fire Department for issue of Fire safety certificate etc. will summarily be rejected in Stage - III itself.

Stage - IV: The application form will be accepted after the BIE carries out preliminary verification. The Management / Society / Trusts should submit the hard copies of the same in duplicate along with copies of the enclosures to the concerned RIOs on prescribed dates.

No changes of building, door numbers, building plans, facilities etc. will be allowed once accepted application is downloaded from the website. All edit options will close by 28.02.2012.

As the issue of fire safety certificate usually takes 3 months time, the management / society / trust is permitted, in the first instance, to submit copy of the application and the challan paid to the Fire Safety Department towards issue of Fire safety certificate.

However the NOC for occupancy of the building from Fire Safety Department should be submitted to the BIE on or before 30.04.2012 without failure. Letter of intent (LOI) will not be issued under any circumstances if any certificate including Fire Safety Certificate is not submitted within the prescribed date i.e. 30.04.2012.

The BIE conducts only one comprehensive inspection instead of two, by the inspection team appointed by the Secretary, BIE. The management should see that all the required stipulated conditions are fulfilled before the specified date of inspection in all aspects.

In exceptional conditions, if a second inspection is required, the management / society / trust have to bear the cost of second inspection fee.

The managements, those who have obtained access to the website, can attend a pre-registry meeting on 08.02.2012 at 11:00 AM in the meeting hall of the BIE to seek guidelines if necessary.
