This is to inform that the English syllabus of I year Intermediate Course has been changed with effect from the academic year 2010-11. The integrated book InterNET-1 containing the text, non-detailed text and grammar prescribed by the Board of Intermediate Education and prepared by English and Foreign Languages University is priced at Rs.85/-.

A work book and audio CD for InterNET-1 are also prepared by the English and Foreign Languages University, Hyderabad to aid the students. These books will be available in the market from 1<sup>st</sup> week of June 2010.

It is also informed that the syllabi of II year Economics, Civics, History, Commerce, Public Administration, Sociology, Geography, Geology and Logic under Part-III have been revised which will be effective from this academic year 2010-11. New text books for these subjects prescribed by the Board of Intermediate Education and prepared by the Telugu Akademi will come into effect from the academic year 2010-11 and will be available in the market very shortly.

It is further informed that in the Sanskrit text book under Part-II for I year Intermediate which came into effect from 2008-09, the lesson ‘Bethalakatha’ was replaced by ‘Bhojasyakshama’ and the lesson ‘Indumathiswayamvaram’ was revised by changing the theme. On the whole, the text book and non- detailed text book were thoroughly edited and revised. They will be effective from 2010-11. In view of these changes, the instructions circulated to the lecturers during 2008-09 to overcome the objections raised on certain parts of the text book stand cancelled with effect from the academic year 2010-11.

All the Principals are requested to circulate this information among the students and staff and to display this circular in the notice board of the college.
