In continuation of the Press Release vide reference cited, I wish to inform that the Intermediate First and Second year Regular and Private eligible candidates who have not paid the Examination fee within the due dates and the candidates seeking Attendance Exemption (Arts only) can pay the Examination fee under **Tatkal Scheme** for Intermediate Public Examinations March, 2012.

TATKAL SCHEME made available from: 28-11-2011 to 08-12-2011.

- I. Under the Tatkal Scheme, the candidates will pay the Examination fee in their College and forward their applications from the Colleges where they have studied. They will take their Examination at the Centre allotted by the Board of Intermediate Education. Candidate has to pay the Tatkal examination fee in their respective colleges.

II ATTENDANCE EXEMPTION CANDIATES: Due Dates from: 28-11-2011 to 08-12-2011.

A candidate seeking Attendance Exemption has to pay Rs. **500/-** in addition to the examination fee by way of Demand Draft in favour of the Secretary, Board of Intermediate Education, Andhra Pradesh, Hyderabad and submit Attendance Exemption form and Examination Application form along with demand draft to the **Principal of the Government Junior College** as per the above due dates along with original S.S.C, TC, Intermediate Memo of Marks (for Group Change candidates) and a set of attested copies.

- a) Last date for submission of Exemption & Examination application forms by the candidate along with the Demand Draft and enclosures in the college is **08-12-2011.**

b) Last date for submission of I & II Year M. N. Rs of Attendance Exempted candidates along with Demand drafts and enclosures by the Principal in R.I.O Offices is **09-12-2011**.

c) Candidates who have a gap of one year after passing the qualifying examination i.e., S.S.C. or its equivalent are eligible to appear only for first year examinations and who have a gap of two years after passing the qualifying examination i.e., S.S.C. or its equivalent examination are eligible to appear for both first and second year examinations as private attendance exemption candidates.

III. Intermediate Pass Certificate holders appearing for Mathematics only as **Additional subject** have to submit the attested copies of Intermediate Pass Certificates in the colleges where they have studied previously.

IV. THE FOLLOWING CANDIDATES ARE ELIGIBLE TO PAY THE EXAMINATION FEE UNDER TATKAL SCHEME.

1. First and Second year Regular eligible candidates who have not paid the Examination fee in time.
2. Failed candidates who appeared for Intermediate Public Examinations, **March 2011 & ASE 2011 and earlier**.
3. The candidates admitted into Intermediate course during **2007-2008 and earlier** are eligible to appear for Intermediate Public Examinations, **March 2012** and Intermediate Public Advanced Supplementary Examinations, **May/June 2012 as a last chance** and they cannot claim their old performance to clear backlog papers afterwards.
4. Intermediate Pass Certificate holders who passed Intermediate in March, 2010 & IPASE 2010 and afterwards to appear for **IMPROVEMENT** of their performance.
5. Candidates willing to appear for Intermediate examinations with **change of Group** in Arts combination. Intermediate Pass Certificate holders appearing for **Mathematics or II Language** as additional subjects under Attendance Exemption.
6. Candidates willing to appear privately with Attendance Exemption (Arts group only).

Improvement of Performance:

Chance of improvement should be availed within two years of passing the Intermediate Public Examinations only. Two chances are allowed for improvement, subject to the condition that such candidates do not prosecute their higher studies during this period. An undertaking has to be given to that effect by the candidate.

The attendance exemption and examination application forms can be had from the office of the Regional Inspection Officer, Board of Intermediate Education in the District concerned on payment of Rs. 20/- (Rs.10/- for attendance exemption application form and Rs. 10/- for examination application form).

The above due dates are applicable to both General and Vocational students and also Attendance exempted private candidates for Humanities only (without college study) who wish to appear with change of group for the Intermediate Public Examinations, March 2012.

Incomplete applications and the applications without required enclosures will be rejected.

As such the Principals and the Managements are requested to give wide publicity to the Tatkal scheme fee due dates among the students, parents, and staff of their respective Junior Colleges and also a copy of the same should be displayed on the College Notice Board.
